





Microsoft Active Directory Verification

How to test for Microsoft AD support

1. Find the invitation email. The sender is invites@microsoft.com. The subject is "Transfusion Antibody Exchange Inc. invited you to access applications within their organization". See the next page for an image of the email.
2. Either click the "Accept invitation" link or the "If you accept this invitation, you'll be sent to..." link.
3. Review the images below.
